PEER ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

We believe that every young person deserves opportunities for growth, enjoyment, and social interaction. Our team aims to co-produce a variety of exciting events and activity days designed specifically for people who have a learning disability or are autistic or both, as well as their siblings.

We offer a range of enrichment activities and experiences. Whether you enjoy arts and crafts sessions that stimulate creativity, or unforgettable days spent at the farm interacting with animals and nature; we aim to have something for everyone. Previous activities have included; Bushcraft, climbing, football golf, and play in the parks. This is a taster of what we have offered, all our activities are designed around what the children and young people have asked for that access our sessions.

The activities all provide opportunities for creativity, physical and social development in a safe and inclusive environment.

PARENT/CARER SUPPORT

We understand that being a parent or carer of a person who has a learning disability or is autistic or both, you may sometimes require additional support. Our team runs ongoing 'Coffee & Chat sessions', providing a relaxed and informal space where parents and carers can come together, share their stories, and offer support to one another. Additionally, our 'Walk & Talk sessions' combine the benefits of physical activity with meaningful conversations, allowing parents and carers to connect while exploring the beautiful surroundings of our community.
